

Finding Newspaper Articles at Alden Library

Sources for Current Articles

America's Newspapers- Your first stop for current newspaper articles. This database contains full-text articles from almost 800 currently published daily newspapers from the United States, including the New York Times. Dates of coverage vary, but most go back at least to 1995, and a few go back as far as 1980.

Lexis-Nexis- One of the oldest newspaper databases. Not as easy to search as America's Newspapers, but includes many additional U.S. titles and a few international ones. Many also go back as far as 1980. Be sure to click on the "News" tab, since Lexis-Nexis also contains many other kinds of information.

Factiva- Our library's only source for current Wall Street Journal articles. It includes many other U.S. newspapers, and is especially strong in international newspaper coverage.

Sources for Historical Articles

New York Times Historical

1851- 3 years ago

Contains every article and advertisement since the paper began publication in 1851. As with all these historical newspaper databases, scans of every page are available, so you can see photographs and illustrations.

Washington Post Historical

1877-1991

Similar to the New York Times Historical.

America's Historical Newspapers

1690-1876

Includes a wide variety of U.S. newspapers from the past.

Newspaper Archive

18th century to mid-20th century

Similar to America's Historical Newspapers, but includes more small weekly newspapers. Certain time periods of the Athens Messenger are included.
